Ken Schroeder explained the proposed work, convert front porch into family room. They'd like to move the front door to end to the right.

Geoff Hewell would rather see them leave it as is. Doesn't want to see a blank space there. Tom Daly (Chair), personal prospective, such a classic style, even though it was added later on, it is cracker style. The front porch and door. It really does change the appearance of the structure. Would it be a problem to leave the door there and have a sign says no access? Ken Schroeder – if the door is an issue we'll leave the door.

Uta Hardy is concerned with changing appearance.

Lynn Wilson-Spohrer states it's craftsman style, most likely the piers were there as just a porch with no screen, steps down and probably had a little railing between piers because that is a craftsman style. We should retain the craftsman style.

Ken Schroeder stated he'll leave the piers and little pyramid.

Uta Hardy stated - enclose it but leave the appearance. And steps?

Steps stay per Mr. Schroeder.

Lynn Wilson-Spohrere - Style of windows? Awning?

Mr. Schroeder stated - crank out, length of where screen is now, double each way, glass.

Leave steps, leave door, close in with windows -Tom Daly.

Lynn Wilson-Spohrer suggesting to help Mr. Schroeder with window and door measurements to find something that will work and keep the historical appearance.

Motion to approve was made by Jim Bachrach to accept the design Lynn Wilson-Spohrer and Mr. Ken Schroeder come up with, 2nd by Lynn Wilson-Spohrer. Uta opposed. Motion Carried.
