MAYOR'S ELECTION PROCLAMATION  
MAYORAL ELECTION**

I, the undersigned, Brenda Ash, Mayor pro tem of the City of Apalachicola, by authority of law and pursuant to City Ordinance No. 91-4, do hereby proclaim that on Tuesday, September 7, 2021 an election will be held to fill the office as follows: Mayor-Commissioner for a term of two (2) years, and a Run-Off Election, if necessary, will be held on Tuesday, September 21, 2021.

Candidates wishing to qualify may do so at the City Office from 12 Noon Monday, June 28, 2021 until 12 Noon Friday, July 2, 2021. The City Office is located at 192 Coach Wagoner Boulevard, and regular office hours are from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday – Friday. Each Candidate must pay to the City Clerk at the time of qualifying a qualifying fee of 4.5% of the first year's salary, must be a resident of the City of Apalachicola, and must also be a qualified voter of the State of Florida, County of Franklin, and the City of Apalachicola.

All persons not previously registered to vote may register to vote anytime from now up to 4:30 PM on Monday, August 9, 2021 for the General Election, and Monday, August 23, 2021 for the Run-Off Election at the Office of the Franklin County Supervisor of Elections located at 47 Avenue F, Apalachicola, Florida, hours 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday – Friday.

The polling place will be at National Guard Armory located at 66 4<sup>th</sup> Street in the City of Apalachicola and will be open at 7:00 AM and close at 7:00 PM. Absentee ballots may be obtained by contacting the Office of the Franklin County Supervisor of Elections at place and time noted previously. Only qualified electors will be permitted to vote. Early voting will be conducted from August 28, 2021 to September 4, 2021 at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 47 Avenue F, Apalachicola, Florida from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM.

All residents of the City of Apalachicola not currently registered to vote are urged to register and take part in this election.
